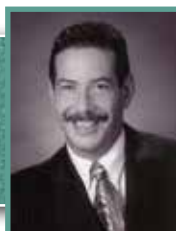

assessment, standardized tools, scoring OATS, complicating factors, radiology medical necessity, red flags in radiology, x-ray report, medical decision-making, CPT versus ICD-10 versus HCPCS, CMT adjustment percentages, ICD-10 basic rules of coding, ICD-10 terminology, treatment plan elements, short versus long term goals, passive therapy documentation, active rehab documentation, SOAP notes, re-examinations, frequency and duration of care, MMI, discharge report, review/questions, responsibilities of the reviewer. The course is taught by Dr. Charles Copeland. Charles T. Copeland, D.C. is a 1995 graduate of Life University in Marietta, Georgia. He is a Certified Insurance Consultant/Peer Review Doctor, is a Medical Compliance Specialist-Physician (MCS-P) and holds CCGPP certification to teach chiropractic guidelines and practice parameter guidelines.
