## Student Eligibility

1. Enrolled in a US, CCE-accredited, chiropractic program.
2. In good academic standing and passed all of NBCE Part I.

## Contest Instructions

1. Submit an original essay on any chiropractic humanities topic: history, philosophy, practice perspectives, jurisprudence/law, ethics, theory, sociology, politics, and all aspects of science or social sciences that address historical or philosophical topics. Examples available at:

2. Email 3 items:
  - a. An original scholarly essay, submitted a Word doc, no more than 3500 words (may be fewer, word count does not include references) format: title page with student contact information, introduction, discussion, conclusion, and references.
  - b. Letter of recommendation from a faculty member or administrator.
  - c. Letter from registrar, with proof of enrollment and good academic standing.
3. The essay will be judged by blinded reviewers. Criteria: relevance to the chiropractic profession, scholarly style, quality of writing, originality, and use of references. Announcements will be made by December 31, 2017.
4. Only one essay is allowed per student per competition and only one author per essay. Students who submitted or won in the past may compete again.
