# SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION

The Sterling Heights Community Foundation is proud to present this application for the 2012 Scholarship Program. Below are descriptions of the nine scholarship options. Twenty-one scholarships will be awarded. Do not apply for more than two scholarships.

Applications must be received by Friday, March 16, 2012.



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## The 2012 scholarships:

1. Sterling Heights Community Foundation - The foundation will award five (5) \$500 scholarships to students pursuing college degrees or vocational training. Awards are based on academics, financial need and community service. This scholarship is for Sterling Heights residents only.
2. The Chrysler Corporation Fund - The fund will award five (5) \$1,000 scholarships to Sterling Heights residents graduating from high school with plans to pursue technical or vocational careers at an accredited college or vocational school. Career choices include, but are not limited to, electrical and mechanical engineering, manufacturing & computer science. Applicants must be 21 or under at the time of application.
3. General Dynamics - The company will award two (2) \$500 scholarships to high school students pursuing undergraduate degrees in mechanical or electrical engineering. Candidates must be residents of Sterling Heights, have a minimum GPA of 3.5, be enrolled in a North American accredited college with an undergraduate concentration in engineering, be a full-time student carrying at least 16 credits and demonstrate involvement in extracurricular and community activities.
4. Macomb County Chiropractic Association - The association will provide three (3) \$1,000 scholarships to students pursuing a career in chiropractic health care. Applicants may be enrolled in undergraduate studies with the intent of becoming a chiropractic physician and may already be enrolled in a chiropractic college. Applicants may also be high school seniors with an intent to study the chiropractic field upon graduation.
5. Rotary Club of Sterling Heights - The club will award two (2) \$500 scholarships to Sterling Heights residents who are either high school seniors or college students. Applicants must have a GPA of at least 3.5 and demonstrate community involvement. The scholarship is open to students pursuing any field.
6. Mayor Richard J. Notte Scholarship for Public Service - The Sterling Heights Community Foundation will award one (1) \$500 scholarship to a Sterling Heights college student pursuing a degree in public service. Applications will be judged on academic achievement, financial need and community service.
7. Tom Kroll Scholarship - The Sterling Heights Community Foundation will award one (1) \$500 scholarship in honor of Tom Kroll, a retired UCS teacher and coach, to a Utica Community Schools student who demonstrates an outstanding commitment to community service, have a minimum GPA of at least 3.0 and demonstrate financial need.
8. Selfridge ANG/Base Community Council Scholarship - The council will award two (2) \$1,000 scholarships to a child of military personnel attached to Selfridge Air National Guard Base. Applicants must be graduating seniors or college students with a GPA of at least 3.2 and be able to demonstrate strong community involvement.
