A Direct Grad PLUS Loan is available to students enrolled half-time or greater in a graduate/professional level program. A student may borrow up to the total cost of attendance minus all financial aid and other resources.

To apply for a Federal Direct Grad PLUS Loan, the student borrower must complete and sign the form below. The Federal Direct Grad PLUS Loan utilizes a Master Promissory Note (MPN), which allows a student 10 years of an active promissory note (in most cases). Although the student should not have to sign a new promissory note for each new loan, the student borrower must authorize a credit check every year and is required to list a specific dollar amount to be borrowed.

A separate Grad PLUS Loan application is required for each loan requested. If the student borrower does not have an active MPN on file, he/she may complete one online at <u>www.studentloans.gov</u>.

I further understand that any remainder of my loans proceeds after subtracting the amount I owe to the Logan will be sent directly to me in the form of a check.
