<u>PubMed</u> is a resource of the National Library of Medicine that is comprised of more than 21 million citations for biomedical literature from MEDLINE, life science journals, and online books. For information on accessing full-text and peer reviewed literature, refer to the <u>PubMed Search Hints</u> handout.



SPORTDiscus with Full-Text is the definitive research tool by EBSCOHost for all areas of sports & sports medicine literature. Use the advanced search to limit your search to full text and/or peer reviewed literature.



Rehabilitation Reference Center is an evidence-based clinical reference tool for use by rehabilitation clinicians at point-of-care. The basic search default will bring up full text articles. Use the advanced search to limit to peer reviewed literature.



DynaMed is a clinical reference tool created by physicians for physicians and other health care professionals for use primarily at the point-of-care with clinically-organized summaries for more than 3,200 topics. Information found in DynaMed is considered peer reviewed.



<u>Index to Chiropractic Literature (ICL)</u> indexes a wide range of chiropractic publications, providing citation information, some abstracts, and some links to full text. ICL does not provide direct links to many of Logan's online journal subscriptions. Check Logan's <u>Journal Holdings List</u> by journal title to locate any available online access. Choose "Yes" under "Peer Reviewed" to limit your search to peer reviewed literature.



The <u>MANTIS</u> database at ChiroACCESS provides abstracts of biomedical literature on manual, alternative, and natural therapies. MANTIS does not link to Logan's online journal subscriptions. Check Logan's <u>Journal Holdings List</u> by journal title to locate any available online access. Use the advanced search to limit your search to peer reviewed literature.



Spine: Chiropractic, from Primal Pictures, on OvidSP, contains interactive anatomy of the spine plus chiropractic examination with information on diagnosis, treatment, manipulation, and adjustment.



Natural Standard is an international research collaboration that aggregates and synthesizes data on complementary and alternative therapies. It provides comprehensive databases on foods, herbs, and supplements. Natural Standard is not a full text source however, links are provided for references in their databases to records in PubMed.



Food Science Source by EBSCOHost is a comprehensive database designed to support the information needs of the food industry. This collection offers information relevant to many areas integral to the food industry encompassing sectors such as food science, food service, and processing. Use the advanced search to limit your search to full text and/or peer reviewed literature.



OvidSP is a web gateway to electronic journals. Logan contracts with Ovid for a number of full-text journals. The OvidSP database allows for searching in each journal title or across all Logan's Ovid journals. Titles include *Spine, Neurology, Journal of Spinal Disorders,* and many more.
