Are tickets still available for the concert?

No, the concert is SOLD OUT and no more tickets are available.

What if I don't have tickets but want to attend?

If you do not have a ticket to The President's Own Marine Band, any available seats will become available on a first-come first-serve to non-ticket holders beginning at 7:15pm on Tuesday, September 9, 2014.

What if I can't use my tickets?

What time do the doors to the venue open?

The exterior doors to the Purser Center will open at 6:30pm.

What time can I take my seat?

You may take your seat when doors open at 6:30 pm. Tickets which have not been accounted for will become void at 7:15 pm and seating for non-ticket holders will begin. If you are not in your seat by 7:15pm, seating will be available on a first-come first-serve basis.

Where is my seat in the auditorium?

The President's Own Marine Band concert is a general admission event. There are no assigned seats. Seats are acquired on a first-come basis.

Is the Purser Center handicap accessible?

Yes, the Purser Center is handicap accessible.

What can I bring into the auditorium?

For security purposes, only small purses are allowed into the auditorium. Any large bags are should remain in your vehicle. Food and beverages are not permitted in the auditorium.
