Trimester One Doctor of Chiropractor's Bag and Equipment

All students entering the Doctor of Chiropractic program will receive the necessary equipment to actively participate in clinical skills and chiropractic technique courses in the first trimester. These supplies include a doctor's bag that contains equipment that students will utilize during the clinical methods and diagnosis courses. This allows students to train with the set of tools that they will use to aid in establishing a diagnosis on a patient during their time at Logan and for the rest of their career as a Doctor of Chiropractic. Students will also receive equipment that will assist them in their development of chiropractic technique skills, such as a speeder board for the second trimester Diversified Course. The equipment and supplies are standard 'tools of the trade' in the chiropractic profession and the goal is to give incoming students early exposure and use of this equipment so that they can continue to develop and refine their diagnostic and management skills as they progress towards their clinical experience. Cost allowances have been included in the tuition for financial aid purposes.
