The Insurance and Compliance Seminar for the Practicing Doctor of Chiropractic**




This weekend we have two acknowledged experts on coding and documentation, compliance, EHR issues, and fraud; Medicare, documentation of medical necessity, and HIPAA updates. This is both a comprehensive overview for the practicing DC, and a comprehensive review for chiropractors who are Certified Peer Review/Insurance Consultants. Drs. Levinson and Hart bring a wealth of information and expertise to their presentations. Every chiropractor who submits insurance reports and bills will feel much more confident in their ability to be compliant, understand and perhaps, avoid audits at the conclusion of the seminar. On Saturday, Dr. Levinson presents *Health Care Fraud, Waste and Abuse: Promoting Appropriate Patient Management, Documentation and Coding*. He covers issues in chiropractic management of musculoskeletal conditions, electronic health records, Medicare issues, physician extenders/documentation, coding and documentation, and schemes and schemers. On Sunday, Dr. Lisa Hart helps us understand OIG compliance requirements, learn documentation guidelines and requirements, become familiar with new ABN regulations, proper use of Medicare modifiers, steps required for a complete chart audit, and OIG self-disclosure protocol. Dr. Hart will provide an overview of how to audit a chart and requires attendees to bring a

sanitized chart for a patient who was new within the last 30 days of attending the class, including 1500 forms/billing information to begin the step-by-step audit process. This seminar is approved for the required Insurance Consultant/Peer Review Missouri Board recertification due this year for those doctors holding that certification. This really is a "don't-miss" seminar. Howard J. Levinson, DC, CFE, AHFI, DAPFP is a 1984 graduate of Logan College of Chiropractic. This weekend renowned acupuncture expert Dr. Gary Ditson presents *Microsystems Acupuncture*. This is a fascinating presentation designed to introduce the 4 acupuncture microsystems to the chiropractor who utilizes acupuncture in his or her practice. He presents methods, implementation, indications, and treatment points with hands-on practice for both types of scalp acupuncture. As the weekend moves along Dr. Ditson presents Hand Acupuncture, again describing two types: Korean Hand Acupuncture and Chinese Hand Acupuncture. He covers various techniques, theories, indications and contraindications, and hands-on practice. He ends this excellent seminar with Auricular Acupuncture. Dr. Ditson is one of the foremost experts in auricular acupuncture and presents an excellent overview of this most popular form of microsystem acupuncture, including tips on treatment of major illnesses and treatment of addictions. As with all of these presentations he also includes a hands-on workshop

on auriculotherapy. Gary D. Ditson, D.C., L.Ac. is a 1968 graduate of Logan College of Chiropractic and he is a licensed acupuncturist in the state of Illinois. We are happy to welcome Dr. Jeff Miller back on campus. Dr. Miller is a renowned lecturer and author, and this weekend he presents Practical Assessment of the Chiropractic Patient. He starts off this very practical seminar with a demonstration of: the Five Maneuvers Screening Examination, 6 Categories of Neurological Examination, 16 Bullet Examination, and a discussion of efficiency versus shortcuts. 
