Scholarship Criteria:

2. Currently enrolled trimester 7 or 8 Doctor of Chiropractic (DC) student
3. Cumulative DC GPA of 3.5 or above

Application Criteria:

1. Complete scholarship application in full detail
2. Complete an essay describing your first career and what made you decide to study chiropractic (please provide **only** your student identification number in the upper right hand corner)
