Student Eligibility

- 1. Enrolled in a US, CCE-accredited, chiropractic program at any time during 2018.
- 2. In good academic standing and passed all of NBCE Part I by October 1, 2018.

Contest Instructions

- Submit an original essay on any humanities topic relevant to chiropractic, which
 includes: history, philosophy, practice perspectives, jurisprudence/law, ethics, theory,
 sociology, politics, or social sciences. Examples of articles with humanities topics

- 2. To enter the competition, submit 3 items by email:
 - a. An original essay, submitted as a Word document. Maximum 3500 words, may be fewer, word count does not include references. Include title page with student name, cell phone, and email.
 - b. Letter of recommendation from a faculty member or administrator.
 - c. Letter from registrar confirming enrollment and good academic standing.
- Judging criteria: relevance to the chiropractic profession, scholarly style, writing quality, originality, and use of references. Announcements of winning essays will be made by December 31, 2018.
- 4. Only one essay is allowed per student per competition and only one author per essay. Students who submitted or won in the past may compete again.
- 5. Email materials to NBCEstudentscholarship@gmail.com by October 1, 2018.
