## PROMISE AWARD SCHOLARSHIP

*The mission of Logan University's College of Chiropractic is to prepare students to become Doctors of Chiropractic who are superbly educated and clinically competent practicing portal-of-entry chiropractic physicians. The Promise Award will honor applicants demonstrating great promise in supporting the fulfillment of our mission and vision and eventual service to patients through the practice of chiropractic.*

This is a one-time, \$2,500 - \$5,000 scholarship, to be awarded to a selected number of new students entering the Doctor of Chiropractic program for the 2016 fall trimester. The recipients will be selected through a blind selection process. Qualified applicants must demonstrate satisfaction of the following scholarship and application criteria:

Scholarship Criteria:

1. An entering Trimester 1, full-time, DC student
2. An entering cumulative GPA of 3.5 or above

Application Criteria:

1. Completed applications (scholarship and admission)
2. Official transcripts from all undergraduate institutions attended
3. Completed 500-750 word essay describing how the applicant plans to contribute to the vision and mission of Logan University while they are a student. The essay should also describe how the applicant plans to serve patients through the practice of chiropractic after graduation.
