Overview

Coaches prepare athletes/teams for success on the field of play prior and during the games.

Requirements

- Successfully pass the National Center for Safety Initiatives' (NCSI) background screen in accordance with the current USOC Games Background Check Policy prior to nomination.
 - Should a nominee experience any event between the time the background check is conducted and the relevant Games that may change his/her background check status, the nominee must inform the Logan University (Logan) and/or USOC
- Possess a valid passport that does not expire until at least six months after the conclusion of the Games.
- Have the ability to work effectively with the HPMO.
- Have strong communication and organizational capabilities/skills.
- Be responsible for athletes' adherence to all rules regarding discipline at the Games.
- Be available for entire duration of the Games
- Possess high level, specific technical and tactical knowledge of the sport.
- Have thorough knowledge and understanding of the IF rules and regulations governing the sport.
- Demonstrate ability to establish harmonious relationships with athletes and other Team personnel.
- Be in good health and able to withstand the physical rigors of traveling with and working with the Team.
- Successfully completes all Games registration requirements by stated deadline.
- Possess a high level of specific technical and tactical knowledge of the sport including the
 weight and kit check process, knowledge of the warm up process and how to warm up, how
 to work the competition board, strapping and the protest procedures.
