

CANDIDATES FOR GRADUATION OF THE APRIL 25, 2020 COMMENCEMENT:

Degrees Will Be Conferred On: Monday, April 27, 2020

What does this mean?

From the moment your degree has been conferred, you are an official legal graduate of Logan University and can use any titles associated with that award. *Degree conferral is dependent upon final grade submission to the Office of the Registrar.*

Things to do before your degree is conferred:

- Clear any outstanding balances with the Office of the Bursar (emily.madden@logan.edu)
- Return LRC materials and pay fines (jocelyn.buermudez@logan.edu)
- Complete Locker Checkout with Student Affairs (laura.kuennen@logan.edu)
- Complete Exit Counseling with Financial Aid (financialaid@logan.edu). Ashley Nickell has emailed information concerning exit counseling and mailing information.

When do I get my diploma?

Diplomas will be mailed 3-4 weeks after the original April 25 graduation date. Diplomas will be mailed directly from the diploma vendor, Paradigm, using the permanent address provided on your graduation application. *Should you need to update your mailing address, contact registrar@logan.edu.*

How do I get my transcript?

Unofficial transcripts are available at any time by emailing registrar@logan.edu. You will receive an electronic pdf file of your unofficial transcript within one business day.

Official transcript requests can be made online [here](#). There is a \$5 fee for official transcripts and a payment page will populate after you submit your request. Doctor of Chiropractic graduates will have a copy of your diploma included when you make an official transcript request online to a state board.

Will there be a Graduation Breakfast and Award Ceremony?

Yes! A virtual Award Ceremony will take place and details will be provided as they become available. Candidates are welcome to attend the Graduation Breakfast scheduled on August 21 at 8:00 am. Candidates who would like to receive their award in person may do so by attending the Graduation Award Ceremony scheduled on August 21 at 9:00 am. Both events will take place in the Purser Center on Logan University's campus. Candidates receiving an award will be emailed by the University Events Department.

Will I still receive honors?

Yes! An honor cord will be provided at the Graduation Breakfast and Award Ceremony on Friday, August 21. If you do not attend the breakfast, but do attend the Commencement Ceremony, your cord will be given to you with your hood on before the ceremony. If you do not attend the commencement ceremony, your hood and cords will be mailed to you.

When is the graduation ceremony?

The Commencement Ceremony originally scheduled for April 25, 2020 is rescheduled to August 22, 2020 at 4:00 pm. This ceremony will include candidates from the April 2020 College of Chiropractic only. Degree candidates from the College of Health Sciences will participate in the August 22, 2020 Commencement Ceremony beginning at 10:00 am. The ceremony will include participants from the April and August College of Health Science classes and the August College of Chiropractic Class.

I can't wait to attend the rescheduled ceremony in August! Is there anything I must do?

The University Events team will contact April graduates regarding participation in the August Ceremony in late June. At this time, you will not need to fill out an additional application for graduation. As details change, you will be notified, and the website will be updated.

Wait – I'm receiving 2 degrees, which ceremony should I attend?

April College of Chiropractic Degree Candidates also receiving a degree from the College of Health Sciences should attend the Saturday, August 22 ceremony that begins at 4:00 pm. Both degrees will be conferred during the ceremony.

Do I have to attend the rescheduled graduation ceremony in August?

While we would love to celebrate your accomplishment with you in person, attendance is not required. Your name will still be printed in the program and announced during the ceremony. You may watch the live stream of the Commencement Ceremony on Logan's website.

I already have my graduation regalia, what do I do with it?

Keep it! Should you decide to participate in the August 22 commencement ceremony, bring the regalia with you to campus to wear in the ceremony. The hood will be provided to you the morning of the ceremony. Regardless of your participation in the ceremony, the regalia is yours to keep and wear in future academic ceremonies.

I'd love to attend the Commencement Ceremony in August but can't. How do I get my hood?

The University Events team will mail any awards, cords and hoods 2 weeks after the August ceremony. The mailing address used for your diplomas will be used. Please update your address should it change between May and August (jessica.goodman@logan.edu)
