As the current competition cycle will end after the Tokyo Paralympic Games and new Technical and Classifications Rules and Regulations will be implemented in October 2021, all Classifiers must renew their licenses and levels by participating in a Recertification Course for 2021 to 2025.

All Classifiers regardless of their level or recent activity are required to participate and pass the examinations in the course or else their license will become inactive.

Please note that a grant programme for Classifiers experiencing financial hardship will be available to enable them to participate in the course.
