The Higher Learning Commission (HLC) will be visiting Logan's campus Oct. 25-26 as part of its Comprehensive Evaluation. This review leads to an action regarding the reaffirmation of the institution's accreditation.

The team will evaluate the institution to determine the extent to which it fulfills the Criteria for Accreditation, provides consultation relative to the ongoing improvement of the institution, and recommends the affiliation status that the institution should have with HLC.
