Policy Title

College of Chiropractic - Elective Technique Use in the Health Centers

Policy Statement

Students who are enrolled in the Trimester 7-10 Clinic courses may only use elective techniques on Logan Health Center patients if they have successfully passed the elective class prior to entering the clinic system. The use of an elective technique in the

Logan Health Center system requires that the elective course be taken as part of the DC curriculum.

Student interns currently enrolled in a technique class may use the elective technique on a patient in the clinic system if they have successfully passed the midterm exam given for that elective technique prior to providing patient care during that trimester of enrollment.

Procedures

Elective Technique instructors will email the list of all students who passed their course at the end of each trimester to the Director of the Health Centers so that this information can be disseminated to the clinicians for reference when their student interns are treating a patient in the clinic system. In addition, for Trimester 7 and above students, their midterm grade will be submitted by Week 8 to the Director of the Health Centers as well. It is up to the clinician to monitor what technique courses their interns have passed and that the students have the appropriate sticker for each elective passed is on their badge.

The Director of the Health Centers will create a process for purchasing and disseminating these elective stickers for the intern badges.
